Cookie Policy and Procedure

Introduction

To comply with the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR), Cassiltoun Stables Nursery will ensure that appropriate information is added to our website to enable us to gain lawful consent from users for the placement of Cookies on their device.

Procedure

Cassiltoun Stables Nursery will have a cookies pop-up banner on our website that allows the user to opt-in or opt-out to any non-essential cookies. Essential cookies are any cookies that are required to make the website work correctly, such as for remembering user logins, displaying images correctly etc. Cookies for analytics or marketing/profiling purposes as classed as non-essential and the user must have the choice to actively opt-in to these if they wish.

A link will be provided on the Cassiltoun Stables Nursery website home page to a 'Cookies Notice', worded as follows:-

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that contain a string of characters. Cookies help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service, for instance by storing information about your preferences and allowing us to recognise you when you return to our websites.

Which cookies do we use?

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around our websites and use features, such as accessing secure areas of the site or remembering language choices. Without these cookies, we would not be able to provide you with services like enabling appropriate content based on your type of device. These cookies must remain on when you choose the 'Reject All' button.

Name Of Cookie	Purpose	Data retention
PHPSESSID	This cookie is native to PHP applications. The cookie is used to store and identify a users' unique session ID for the purpose of managing user session on the website. The cookie is a session cookie and is deleted when all the browser windows are closed	Session

- **Preference Cookies:** Preference cookies are used to collect information about your preferred settings (including offline advertising settings)

Google	NID	User consent Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR	NID cookie, set by Google, is used for advertising purposes; to limit the number of times the user sees an ad, to mute unwanted ads, and to measure the effectiveness of ads	6 months
